NO.CON-3/PAP/65/10 // In exercise of the powers conferred by section (4) of the Bengal Eastern Frontier Regulation, 1873 and in supersession of earlier Notification of even number Dated 09/12/2019 regulating the prescribed fees for issuance of Inner Line Permit to non-indigenous persons crossing the Inner Line in the State of Nagaland, the Governor of Nagaland is pleased to revise the fees for the issuance of Inner Line Permits to such persons.

1. The Fee Structure for various categories of Inner Line Permits shall be hereby revised as follows:

8.	Students	Upto 5 Years or course duration whichever is earlier	300	-	Aadhaar, ID Card from the School/College/ Institutions indicating the course and the years of study. No Local Guarantor
9.	Partners in Business	3 Years (applicable for one time renewal of 3 years)	5000	3000	Aadhaar, Registered Company/Business.

2. Those LLP Applicants coming from the State of Assam i.e. Karimganj, Haikandi, Dima Hasao and Karbi Anglong will be required to produce National Register of Citizens (NRC) in addition to the documents cited above.
3. The system of issuing LLP in online mode shall be introduced immediately wherever feasible and all issuance of LLP in off-line mode shall be discontinued w.e.f. 31st December 2024. All concerned Officers shall ensure that facilitation counters for providing necessary assistance.
4. For any clarifications on LLP issuance, the Commissioner Nagaland will refer the matter to the Home Department whose decision will be final.
